### REGISTRATION CONDITIONS

- Preamble:** The regulation of Controlled Substances and Dangerous Drugs as provided for by Title 44, Chapter 53, Article 3 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina represents an urgent public interest. If the law is to be properly enforced and inspection made effective, inspections without warrant must be deemed reasonable official conduct. The Registrant has chosen to engage in a pervasively regulated business, with the knowledge that his business records, supplies and inventories of controlled substances will be subject to effective investigation.
- Conditions:** Registrant's business premises shall be subject to inspection without a warrant by authorized Drug Inspectors during normal business hours for the reasons contained in Section 44-53-500(b)(4), such inspection to encompass the conduct of accountability audits of supply and inventory of controlled substances, if necessary.
